Introduction

Objectives

The main objectives of the program are:

- To foster a sense of community and belonging among the Nepalese diasporas.

Program Design

The program will be face to face interaction opportunity organized by the Everest TV Community Media in collaboration with local Nepalese Community Organizations, Student Groups, Community Media, Community Leaders, and other Stakeholders. Those who cannot attend the program, especially living in a regional area or interstate, can participate through audio or video link.

Evaluation

The success of the program will be analysed and documented as a report through various measures, such as:

- Attendance rates and feedback from participants and focus groups.
- Quantitative data on the program's reach and engagement collected through social media analytics and website traffic.
- Panel discussions will be analysed and documented as a report by the Analyst panel.

• The analyst panel will consist of 8 members from various backgrounds who will prepare the evidence-based report based on the survey, panel interactions and responses by the speaker of the program.

Expected Outcome

Identifying problems and solutions through interaction is a critical step in addressing the burning issues of the Nepalese diaspora. This program will provide a unique and valuable opportunity for Nepalese communities to express their problems, connect and resolve the everyday issues of the communities.






Nepalease Population in Australia

At the end of June 2021, 129,870 Nepalese-born people were living in Australia, almost five times the number (27,810) on 30 June 2011. This is the eleventh largest migrant community in Australia, equivalent to 1.7 per cent of Australia's overseas-born population and 0.5 per cent of Australia's total population.
